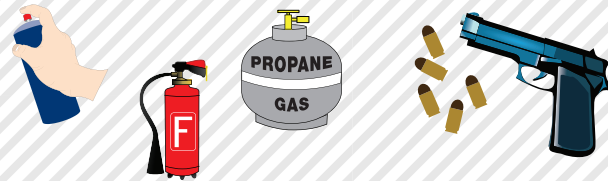

- Pesticides



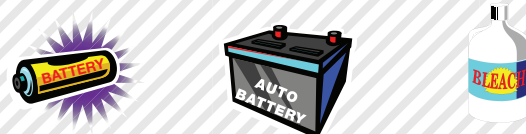
- Compressed Gas

- Ammunition



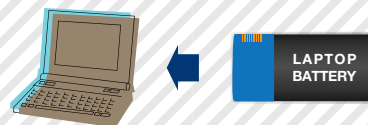
* Even if empty, a propane tank in your shipment may cause an inspection or rejection of your shipment, creating delays and increasing costs.

- Rechargeable Lithium Batteries



Rechargeable lithium batteries used to power laptop computers are classified “hazardous” (flammable) by the US Federal Aviation Administration and prohibited from inclusion within an unaccompanied air cargo shipment. Rechargeable lithium batteries must be removed from a laptop computer (or any device) for transport. We recommend rechargeable lithium batteries be included within carry-on luggage or a surface shipment.
